Opening: Read Hebrews 10:19-25. From this passage, what truths impacted you the most?

1. What do the following passages tell us about having "our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience?"

a. Isaiah 43:25

b. Ezekiel 36:25-27

c. 1 Corinthians 6:11

d. 2 Peter 1:9 (read verses 3-8 for context)

e. 1 John 1:9

2. How should the truths from the above passages affect the way you live (thoughts/attitudes/actions/speech)?
