3. Read the following passages on prayer: Ephesians 6:18-20, Colossians 4:2-4, Philippians 4:6-7, 1 Timothy 2:1-2 and 2:8, and 1 Thessalonians 5:17-18.

a. List the things Paul is challenging us to go after in regard to prayer.

b. In which areas are you stronger?

c. In which areas are you weaker?

d. How can you grow in these weaker areas?
