## DAY 1

**Pray:** Ephesians 1:17 “...that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.” Open your study this week by praying that God would give you wisdom and reveal to you a greater understanding of His nature and His glory.

**Memorize:** John 17:17-18. Please read through these verses several times today. Try to read it a bit differently each time – slowly and silently at first, then out loud. Finally, read it through intentionally, focusing on the pronouns. Who is being referred to by each of these words? Who is Jesus praying for and who is doing the action?

**Study:** According to *Desiring God* by John Piper the term *glory of God* refers to the visible splendor or moral beauty of God’s perfection. The word *glorify/glory* is from the Greek word *doxa* which is also translated as dignity, honor, praise.

## DAY 2

## DAY 3

**Pray & Memorize:** Today as you memorize John 17:17-18, consider making these words the prayer of your heart. **Pray:** In closing, pray through Psalm 99:1-5. Glorify God for His holiness. Praise God – He is on His throne!

## DAY 4

**Pray:** Psalm 105:3, “Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice.” As you open your study today, give glory to God for His holiness. Ask Him to give you joy as you seek Him in humility.

**Memorize:** Read through John 17:17-18 several times. Read aloud if it helps you remember better. Once you have refreshed your memory, close your eyes and try to say the verses out loud – without looking if possible!

As you focus in prayer on glorifying God in His holiness, ask Him to reveal areas of your heart and life that He would like to cleanse. Respond to Him by committing your desire to do as He has asked.



## DAY 5

**Pray:** 2 Corinthians 4:6, "For God who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness,' has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ." As we begin to study the glory of God this week, pray that God will enlighten your heart with the knowledge of His glory as seen in the life of Christ.

**Memorize:** Write John 17:17-18 on the lines below.
