QUESTIONS

Opening: Read John 20:1-10. From the passage/sermon, what truths impacted you the most?

2. John and Peter had very different approaches when arriving at the empty tomb. John arrived first but would not enter at first, but followed Peter who went right in.

a. How is God calling you to lead someone with boldness (like Peter) to the hope that is in the resurrection of Jesus?

1. Imagine being in Mary and Peter's situation.

a. What range of emotions would you be going through?

b. How is this similar to a seemingly hopeless situation you may have gone through?

Application: Think of someone that needs to know this "unimaginable truth." Pray that person's heart would be softened to hear the Gospel. Pray too for an opportunity to share this hope with them and the boldness to do it!

b. What truths about Christ would you share with this person?

c. What is God calling you to believe about Him when things seem hopeless?
