IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

Opening: Read Daniel 2:31-49. From the passage/sermon, what truths impacted you the most?

1. What are the main events in the flow of the story?

a. How did Daniel interpret Nebuchadnezzar's dream?

b. What character traits did Nebuchadnezzar attribute to the Lord?

2. In this story, we see a great picture of our God who is true.

a. How do you see God as true in this story?

b. In your life, how do you see God as true and trustworthy?

3. Read Psalm 147:1-11.

a. What truths do you find about God from these verses?

b. How can you apply those truths to specific circumstances you're going through?

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

4. Read Psalm 139. God is omniscient—He knows everything, omnipresent—He is everywhere, and omnipotent—He is all-powerful.

a. List how God interacts with us in his omniscience (1-6), omnipresence (7-12), and omnipotence (13-16).

b. How does this help you place your trust more fully in Him?

c. From verses 23-24, in light of God's character, what does our worshipful response look like?

d. Which of these characteristics do you need to cling to right now? Why?

Application: What truths from God's word do you need to take hold of to rely on God's faithfulness rather than your feelings?
