

Bible Summary

Today, we are learning about the book of Judges. In Judges 4:4-16, we read about Deborah who was a prophet and judge of God who brought guidance to Israel. The time of Deborah takes place about 200 years after Israel had escaped from Egypt. The Israelites forgot what God had done for them during that time so they began to serve other gods. As a result of their disobedience to God, the Israelites struggled under the rule of the Canaanites. After 20 years of struggling, they began to cry out to God for help. God heard their cries. He told Deborah to tell Barak, the leader of the Israelite army, to go into battle against the Canaanite army. God said he would bring victory to the Israelites by handing the Canaanites into their hands. Deborah went with Barak and the Israelite army into battle where they had victory over the Canaanites. God lead Israel into victory through the guidance of Deborah. We, too, can follow God as he leads and guides us throughout our lives. This promise is seen in Psalm 32:8, where we can obey God in every situation we face knowing our loving God watches over us!
