

ADVENTURES of Joseph

Date: October 18, 2020

What we are learning:

Today we're on the second week of our series, "The Adventures of Joseph." The life of Joseph is found in the book of Genesis. In Genesis 37:12-36, our story of Joseph picks up where we left off last week. Jacob asked his son Joseph to go check on his brothers who were watching over their sheep. While Joseph was checking on his brothers, they came up with a plan to get rid of him. They threw Joseph in a well with no water. When the brothers saw some Ishmaelite people who were on their way to Egypt, they sold Joseph to them. Joseph's brothers didn't want to get in trouble so they lied to their dad, Jacob, saying Joseph had been killed by an animal. Jacob was brokenhearted and mourned for Joseph. Meanwhile, Joseph was sold to one of Pharaoh's officials, Potiphar. This situation seemed awful; however, God was using it for His good. In Psalm 62:8, it says we can trust in God at all times, not just when things are going well, but also when things are difficult and we don't understand the plan. We are told to trust in God as He is our refuge.

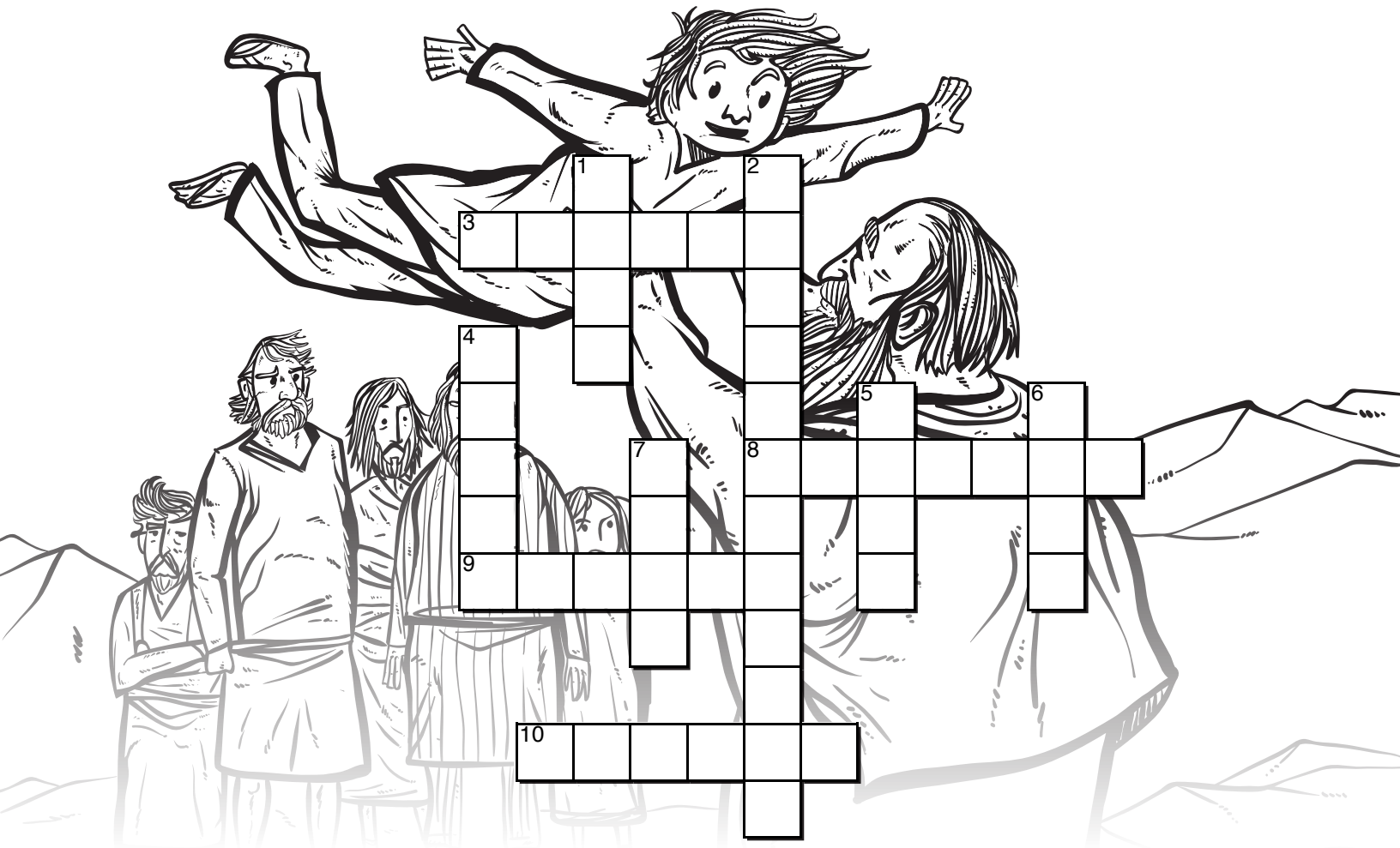
