Passage Genesis 44:1-34; 45:1-15

Main Point God has a plan.

Application I can trust God.

Bible Summary

Last week we learned that Joseph's brother came to him in Egypt when they had no food to eat in Canaan. Joseph recognized his brothers, but they did not recognize him. Joseph sent them back to their father in Canaan with food, but asked them to return to Egypt with their younger brother. Today as we finish our series Adventures of Joseph, we learn that his brothers came back to Egypt with their younger brother and ate a special dinner with Joseph. Then Joseph sent his brothers home with more food and then ordered his officials to go after them and bring them back to him. When his brothers returned to him, Joseph told them who he was. At first his brothers were scared, because they knew that they had treated him poorly and sold him into slavery. Joseph remembered these things too, but he told them not to be afraid because God had a plan all along to send Joseph ahead of his brothers to be able to provide food for the people during the seven years of famine. It had been nearly 20 years between the time that Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery and when Joseph revealed to his brothers who he was. Although it may have been hard to understand all that Joseph went through those years, God was with him throughout all of it and He had a plan that was good. As believers, we can always trust God and His plan for our lives.

Digging Deeper

Have a family game night and while you are playing the game, talk with your child about what they have learned about Joseph the last few weeks. What have they learned about God? Talk with your child about a time that you didn't understand why things were happening in your life. How did God show you His faithfulness during that time?
