Passage John 11:1-44

Main Point Only Jesus can forgive my sins.

Application Jesus loves me.

Bible Summary

This week as we continue with our series Jesus Can, we learn about a time that the brother of two of Jesus' close friends was very sick. Mary and Martha sent a message to Jesus to let him know their brother Lazarus was sick. When Jesus heard, he said that Lazarus would not die, but instead God would use his sickness to show His glory. Jesus stayed where He was for two more days and before leaving, Jesus told His disciples Lazarus had died, but that they would believe in and have faith in Jesus. By the time Jesus got to where Lazarus was he had already been in the tomb for four days. Martha thought that if Jesus would have been with Lazarus sooner, he would not have died. However Jesus said this would be an opportunity for the Lord to be glorified and for the people to see His power. Jesus went to Lazarus' tomb and called for him to come out. Lazarus walked out of the tomb fully healed!! When Jesus raised Lazarus from the tomb, it gave us a picture of what only Jesus can do for all those to trust Him as Savior. Jesus loves us and wants us to live with Him forever and when we trust Jesus as our Savior, He is able to forgive our sins and make a way for us to live with Him forever.

Digging Deeper

Take some time to play a game together as a family. As you are playing the game, talk about some things that are powerful. Maybe a big truck, a favorite super hero, or someone in your family. Remind your child that Jesus said His power would be shown through Lazarus' sickness. Explain to you child that Jesus is more powerful than anyone or anything else. Only Jesus has power over death and only Jesus can make a way for us to live with Him forever!
