Today's Main Point

Jesus cares for me.

Bible Summary

A shepherd takes care of his sheep and protects them from danger. Many times throughout the Bible, people who love God and trust Jesus are called sheep. In the book of Daniel, we learn about a time that King Darius made a law that the people could only pray to him and they couldn't pray to God or anyone else. King Darius had chosen Daniel to be the third highest ruler in the kingdom, and that made some of the other leaders upset. They convinced the king to create a law that people could only pray to him. Daniel loved God and continued to pray to God. When the other leaders saw what Daniel was doing, they told the king. The king was upset because he knew Daniel would be thrown into the den of lions as punishment for disobeying the law. Daniel was thrown into the den with the lions and stayed there all night, but when the king had the den opened the next morning, he found God had protected Daniel. David was not hurt at all by the lions. Again, all signs point to Jesus who protects and cares for us.
