

# Date April 7, 2021 Bible Reference Zechariah 9:1-17

### **Today's Main Point**

Jesus is our King.

### **Bible Summary**

Zechariah was a prophet to the Jews who had returned to Jerusalem after 70 years of being held captive in Babylon. He was a prophet during the same time as Haggai and both of these prophets encouraged the people to rebuild the temple. Zechariah also gave a very clear message to the people of the coming Savior. Zechariah told the people their King would come riding on a donkey. At that time, when a king came riding on a donkey, it meant the king was coming in peace. Again we see all signs pointing to Jesus as this prophecy was fulfilled in Matthew 21:5 when Jesus entered Jerusalem as King riding on a donkey.

"Say to Daughter Zion, 'See, your king comes to you, gentle and riding on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey."" Matthew 21:5
