Passage Exodus 7-14

Main Point God protects.

Application God protects me.

Bible Summary

Last week we learned about God protecting and saving baby Moses. As Moses grew up in Pharaoh's courts he saw how his family the Israelites were slaves and being treated so harshly. One day, God spoke to Moses and told him of His promise to Abraham. He told Moses to go and talk to Pharaoh, but Moses wasn't sure Pharaoh would listen. God reminded Moses He would help him. God told Moses to go to Pharaoh and tell him to let the Israelites go, but God also told Moses that Pharaoh would not listen. God told Moses He would send many signs of His power through plagues on Egypt, but still Pharaoh would not listen. After the last plague Pharaoh would finally listen and tell the Israelites to leave Egypt. God lead the people out of Egypt and made a way through the Red Sea. The Egyptians tried to chase after the Israelites and bring them back to Egypt, but God moved between the Egyptians and the Israelites stoping them from reaching the Israelites. God is powerful and able to keep all his promises. We all sin, but God has promise to make a way out of our sin through Jesus. Just as God protected the Israelites from the Egyptians, He protects us and save us from the punishment of our sins.

Digging Deeper

It might have seemed impossible for the Israelites to escape Egypt, but all things are possible with God. Talk with your child about a time something has seemed impossible, but God made a way. Remind your child God loves them, cares about them, and can protect them. God may not do everything we want, but we can know He is able and we can trust His plan. When we trust in Him, He is able to protect us and save us from the punishment of our sin.
