Today's Main Point

Jesus wants me to follow Him.

Bible Summary

Last week we learned prophets in the Old Testament told people God would send a Savior and King who would rule forever. The book of Mark focus's on things Jesus did while on Earth. The New Testament opened with that promise coming true. Jesus grew up and it was time for others to begin to know who He is. In the Old Testament, God used prophets to tell others about Jesus, but in the New Testament Jesus would call His disciples. One day as Jesus was walking near the Sea of Galilee, He saw two brothers fishing and He asked them to follow Him to they could learn to fish for people. Jesus didn't mean He was going to teach the men to catch people like they caught, fish though. Instead, Jesus would teach them to tell others about Him so more and more people could know Him and follow Him! Jesus wants everyone to know Him and follow Him.
