Bible Summary

After the book of Acts there are 21 books written as letters. The first thirteen of these were written by Paul and the last eight were written by other people. Paul wrote this letter to the church at Rome. This is the longest letter Paul wrote and in this letter he explained foundational truths of the Christian faith. At this time the ruler of Rome didn't like Christians and many of them were being persecuted. Paul wrote this letter to the church of Rome to help them to better understand their faith and cling to their hope in Christ. In this letter, we are reminded we are all sinners in need of a Savior. God sent His Son Jesus to save us from our sin and when we trust Him as Savior our sins are forgiven and we are able to live with Him forever.
