Bible Summary

Lesson Summary:

In Acts 10, we read how God made the way for Gentiles, people who aren't Jewish, to come to know Jesus. God used Peter and a man named Cornelius to show Jesus died for *all* people, not just for Jewish people. This chapter takes place 10 years after the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Before this chapter, we see how much of the Jewish community rejected the apostles teaching of Jesus Christ. God was continuing to prepare the way for others to hear the Gospel.

God used a Roman man named Cornelius to show Peter the Gospel message is for all people. Cornelius was obedient to God's law, yet he knew he was missing something. He was not a saved man. God sent an angel to Cornelius with instructions. At this same time, God was showing Peter through the visions of the clean/unclean animals that salvation was indeed for *all* people. Both the Jewish people and Gentile people were sinners in need of a Savior. We see here all people who have put their trust in Jesus will be united together under the One True God.
