DIGGING DEEPER

As you are driving in the car, talk about the equipment that is needed to play different sports. What does the equipment do? Why is it needed? How many pieces of armor can your child name? How are the pieces of armor like the equipment used in sports? How is the armor different?



As you are eating a meal together, talk about the best parts of the day and the worst parts of the day. How can God’s armor help us each day?



Before bed, read a Bible story together and ask your child if they can think of any place where God’s armor was at work. How can God’s armor help them each day? Pray with your child, praising God for giving us His armor and asking Him to help us to put on each piece everyday.



Write down our Bible verse and place it somewhere you and your child will see it often. Each time you see the verse, say it together. Set a goal to try to memorize the verse by the end of August.
