Bible Summary

On Sunday, we learned about Adam and Eve disobeying God and eating the fruit from the tree. We all sin, but God made a promise after the fall that one day Jesus would defeat Satan for good. God keeps all His promises and He has a plan for Jesus to come back, for Him to defeat Satan, and for all those who trust in Him to live with Him forever in a perfect forever home. All through the Old Testament, God promises to send a Savior and when Jesus died on the cross and defeated death, He made a way for all those who trust in Him to be saved from the punishment of their sins and to live with Him forever.
