

Bible Summary Last week, we learned about Adam and Eve sinning in the garden. Many years after this, there were many people living on Earth, but they were all choosing to disobey God. God was upset that these people He created didn't know Him, were being so mean to each other, and were disobeying Him. God created us to know God, to follow Him, and to tell others about Him. God was so upset to see His creation not loving Him and disobeying Him that He planned to destroy everything He created by flooding the whole Earth. There was a man named Noah who loved God and his family loved God too. God told Noah He was going to flood the Earth, but before He did that, He told Noah to build an ark. This very large boat would need to be big enough to hold Noah, his family, and two of every animal God would save.
