IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 45:1-17

Opening: Read Psalm 45:1-17. From the passage/sermon, what truths impacted you the most?

1. In verse 1, the writer describes how his heart is overflowing and his tongue is like a pen, ready to write about his King. Take some time to list what you can worship the Lord for today (His character, provision, promises, etc.).

2. Verse 10 challenges to incline your ear and forget your people.

a. Who, or what has your ear—who are you listening to?

b. What are you holding onto that might be getting in the way of your having a sold out relationship to God?

c. How can you give this to the Lord and let Him have control?
