

**KEY PASSAGE: Psalm 102:12-28** 



1. Verse 12 starts with the words "But you, O Lord..."

b. How do these characteristics encourage you?



2. Read Malachi 3:6, Hebrews 13:8 and Psalm 102:27. God is unchanging and eternal. How do these truths impact the way you encounter and deal with the troubles of this life?

Application: The psalmist was convinced the Lord would hear him and answer his prayer regardless of what was happening around him (vs. 17). What situation(s) in your life do you need to commit to the Lord in prayer, trusting in His plan and timing?
