1. Please compare Hebrews 4:12 with Jeremiah 17:9.

a. How does God's word give us confidence to approach God?

b. Why is the world's view of "following our hearts" not a good idea? Can you give an example of the outcome of following our hearts vs. staying true to God's word?

2. Please describe the words or phrases from this passage that give us reason to be humble and respectful in our approach to God?

3. What obstacles keep us from approaching God?

4. Please compare Hebrews 4:14 with Hebrews 10:11-14. How is Jesus' priesthood different than all other priests?

5. How do we practically "hold fast our confession"?

6. Please explain the difference between mercy and grace and how we need both.

7. Please read vs. 13. How does God's response to seeing us naked and exposed (vs. 14-16) differ from what we might expect? How does this impact your view of God when you're struggling with sin and/or suffering?

8. Jerry Bridges said, "Your worst days are never so bad that you are beyond the reach of God's grace. And your best days are never so good that you are beyond the need of God's grace." Please describe the hope we have for His grace on our worst and best days in Hebrews 4:12-16.
