1. Please compare Isaiah 40:18-20 with vs. 21-26. Looking at the differences between an idol and Almighty God, why do you think people would choose idols over Him?

2. Why are we prone to think that our way is hidden from God and that He disregards our right?

3. What are the 4 theological truths we must keep as tentpoles in addressing racism? Which tentpole do you find hardest to embrace and which do you find easiest, and why?

4. According to this passage, what do we need to do to experience God's strength in our lives and what obstacles do we have to overcome in order to do this?

5. Please list all the attributes you see about God in this passage. Which attribute(s) help you to believe that it's safe to wait on Him?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. See your God as King over all, and Supreme Creator; Rely on your God's amazing provision for supernatural strength)?
