KEY PASSAGE: MATTHEW 27:45-66

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. As you picture the scene of the people standing around watching Jesus die, why do you think Matthew (the author) wrote the phrase in vs. 49, "Jesusyielded up His spirit"? Why is this important for us to understand?
2. Please describe what took place as soon as Jesus "yielded up His spirit." How did the centurion and the people with him respond to this and what would have caused their response?
3. Please compare Matthew 27:57-60 with Isaiah 53:9 (written over 700 years before Jesus' crucifixion). What insight does Joseph's care of Jesus give you about: a. God's power?
b. God's wisdom?
c. God's love?
4. In vs. 62-66, what words did the priests and the Pharisees used to describe Jesus? In light of the fact that they had seen Jesus do so many miracles over the last three years, why do you thin they had such a violent response to Jesus?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Thank Jesus who carried our sin in great agony; Come personally and interact directly with the God of life and hope; Be in awe of the Son of God)?
