4. Please read 1 Timothy 3:8-10, which refers to some of the qualifications for a person to be a deacon in the church. Why do you think it's important that they would be tested?

5. Using vs. 8-9, what reasons would we have for being filled with "inexpressible joy"? What are some things that we often look to for our joy rather than what God says will bring us joy?

6. What evidence do you see in this passage of God's a. Goodness? b. Power? c. Wisdom?
