# IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS KEY PASSAGE: MARK 12:28-40

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

#### **INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART**

1. Vs. 28 says the scribe who approached Jesus "heard them disputing." Please look back at vs. 18-27. Who was disputing and why? How did Jesus handle their pride?

2. In vs. 34, it says that Jesus saw that the scribe answered wisely (vs. 32-33). What does Jesus consider to be wise?

3. In vs. 28-37, what evidence do you see of Jesus' authority?

4. From vs. 35-37, what evidence do you see of Jesus showing what someday would be made clear, that He was both God and man?

5. Please explain each aspect of why Jesus said to beware of the scribes (vs. 38-40). Why do you think Jesus said the scribes would receive greater condemnation?

6. Looking over Mark 12:28-40, please share what matters to the heart of God vs. the things that matter to man.

7. What is one thing you see about Jesus in this passage that stirs your worship in your present life circumstances?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Actively, purposefully, fully pursue your King from a hear of love; Worship Jesus the King from a heart of humility, not pride)?
