IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 TIMOTHY 1:1-7

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please read 1 Timothy 1:2 and Acts 16:1-3 and explain why you think Paul called Timothy his "true child in the faith."
2. Please explain the reasons Paul "urged" Timothy to stay in Ephesus (vs. 3-4) and how those issues are an obstacle to "the stewardship from God that is by faith."
3. Pastor Tim listed three wrong interpretation techniques with the Bible. What are they? Which one do you see most prevalently today and how?
4. Please describe the kind of love that comes from a pure heart, a good conscience, and sincer faith. How is the love of the world different from this kind of love?

5. What are some ways a believer can get caught into swerving from love that motivates a pure heart, a good conscience, and a sincere faith?
6. Why would someone want to be a teacher of God's word without understanding it? How could that be detrimental to the church?
7. What phrases can you point to in this passage to combat the thought that our faith in God is largely "gut feel"?
