

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 1 TIMOTHY 1:8-14

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. How is the law good, and how can it be used unlawfully (see vs. 3-7 for more insight)?

2. How are each of the unlawful acts listed in vs. 9-10 contrary to the ten commandments? How are they contrary to the second greatest commandment, “love your neighbor as yourself”?

3. In what ways does the gospel display sound doctrine?

4. What ministry, whether vocational or secular, do you see that God has entrusted to you and in what ways can you carry that ministry out?

5. From vs 12-14, what actions do you see God taking in Paul's life? What hope does that give you for your life today?

6. Please compare vs. 13-14 with Proverbs 28:13. What insight does this verse in Proverbs give you about how Paul received mercy from God?

7. What evidence of God's grace do you see overflowing in your present circumstances? Think over the last several months, what evidences of His grace do you see in the midst of the pandemic?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Allow God's law to guide your values and your actions; Thank God for the mercy He pours out in salvation)?
