





# IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

## KEY PASSAGE: 2 TIMOTHY 1:8-14

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

### INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. In vs. 8, what's the "therefore" there for, and why is that an important link to the command that follows the word, "therefore"?

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2. What can you find in vs. 9-10 to be Paul's motivation and willingness to suffer in vs. 11?

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3. From what Paul wrote in vs. 9-10, which aspect of Jesus helps you through suffering?

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4. In vs. 12, Paul says that Jesus is able to guard what has been entrusted, and in vs. 14, he tells Timothy to guard what has been entrusted. Please explain through the passage how both of these fit together (both Jesus and us guarding what has been entrusted).

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5. Notice the word “ashamed” which is used 2 times in this passage. As you take note of each of those times, please explain what it means to be unashamed and how that can be lived out.

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## CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Do not be ashamed of the amazing power and love of Jesus; Be a refreshment to others in the church)?
