KEY PASSAGE: 2 TIMOTHY 3:14-17

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. In regards to “continuing” in our faith, why do you think Paul stresses that we need to continue? How will it affect our faith if we’re not actively continuing in what we’ve learned and believed?

2. How do the sacred writings (from the Old Testament) make a person understand salvation?

3. Please compare vs. 16 with Psalm 19:7-9.

a. What are all the benefits of knowing scripture?

b. What insight can you gain from looking at the opposites of those benefits when we don’t continue in what we’ve learned from scripture?

c. Why do you think we tend to look at studying scripture as something we “should” do but are too busy to do?

4. How do you think scripture makes us complete (mature) and how does it equip us for good works?

5. What does the gift of God’s word tell you about His power, wisdom, and love for you?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Stay true to what you already know from God’s word; Continue to dig deep in God’s word, letting Him equip you all the more)?
