2. What implications do you see in the fact that Jesus went to the disciples rather than them going to find Him?

3. Please describe how the different disciples responded when they realized it was Jesus. If you had been with them, which one would you have responded like, and why?

4. Please describe the disciples’ attitudes before they saw Jesus compared with how they were once they were eating with Jesus.

5. What do you see from this passage that displays Jesus'?

a. Deity?

b. Power?

c. Wisdom?

d. Goodness?
