

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: JOHN 21:15-25

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. According to Jesus, how did He want Peter to display his love for Jesus, and how does that display love? How can we display that same kind of love for Jesus, whether in a secular job or in full time ministry?

2. Please read Luke 22:54-62. How did Jesus use this moment in John 21 to restore Peter and show him forgiveness? How does He do this with us?

3. How did Peter's death glorify Jesus?

4. Why do you think Peter asked Jesus what would happen with John after Jesus explained how Peter would suffer for Him?

5. In what ways do we ask that same question of Jesus, and what does comparing ourselves to others reveal about our view of God?

6. People often learn more from what we model than what we say. How did Jesus' life and death model what He called Peter to do?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Follow the One who forgives and restores; Follow the One who has your future in hand)?
