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3. Vs. 12 says, "She does him good, and not harm, all the days of her life." Please explain how a wife can harm her husband (and others) if her heart is controlled by:

a. Anger

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b. Foolishness

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c. Fear

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d. Despair

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4. Please describe the opposite traits of vs. 25-27. What prevents a woman from living this opposite lifestyle?

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5. How does fearing the Lord (worshiping Him in awe and intimacy) keep a woman from being deceived by charm and getting caught up into the vanity of beauty?

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6. How can a man support and honor these traits in a woman, and which of these traits can a man apply to his own life?
