KEY PASSAGE: HABAKKUK 1:12-2:1

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. According to vs. 12, what is and is not God's purpose for allowing the Babylonians to attack, and how does this affect your perspective of God's purpose in your trials?

2. Please note Habakkuk's phrase in vs. 13, the wicked "swallows up the man more righteous than he," and compare it with Romans 3:10, 23. What is wrong with using comparison to determine our guilt or innocence?

3. In the midst of Habakkuk's complaint, how does he still show reverence to God?

4. From vs. 15-17, please explain how Habakkuk describes the depth of the Babylonians intention, attitude, source of worship, and level of success.

5. According to Habakkuk 2:1...

a. Where was he going to go?

b. What was he going to do?

c. What perspective does this give you about his view of God?

d. If this type of attack were coming to our church or your family, how would you respond?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Maintain a focus of healthy worship while you wrestle with deep confusions; Cry out to your God with clarity and wait patiently for His answer)?
