## KEY PASSAGE: HABAKKUK 2:2-5

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

### INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please compare vs. 1 with Romans 15:4. Why do you think the Lord wanted Habakkuk to write his vision down and make it plain? What would be the danger in not writing it down?

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2. What do you think the Lord meant by the purpose statement, "so he may run who reads it"?

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3. What point is God making in vs. 3, and what place does patience have in our faith in God?

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4. Please describe the character traits of the arrogant listed in vs. 4-5. How does turning to God in faith impact those traits?

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5. What do you learn about the character of God from this passage? How is His character different from that of the arrogant?

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## CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Wait patiently and remember well; Live by your faith rather than in spite of your faith)?
