KEY PASSAGE: HABAKKUK 3:1-11

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. In vs. 2, Habakkuk said that he “feared” the Lord’s work, meaning that he was in awe of it. What evidence do you see in vs. 3-7 that warrants awe?

2. What are some works you’ve seen God do in your life that inspire your awe?

3. Habakkuk prayed, “In wrath remember mercy.” What did he mean by that, and what phrases in this passage display His wrath/might and mercy?

4. Please describe some phrases from this passage that clarify to you the bigness of God vs. the smallness of man?

5. How does Habakkuk's statement in vs. 16 display worship and faith?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. A growing faith will celebrate God's stunning character; A growing faith will celebrate God's willingness to address sin and wrong)?
