4. Habakkuk wrote vs. 17-18 in light of his surroundings. Please rephrase vs. 17-18 according to your surroundings.

5. Please read vs. 17-19. Why and how are rejoicing in God possible even when our circumstances are so difficult?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. A growing faith will celebrate God's glorious salvation in this broken world; A growing faith will celebrate God's consistency and trustworthiness)?
