b. Faith vs. doubting toward the good news of the gospel?

4. According to Romans 1:18-20, why are the unrighteous without excuse?

5. Please read Romans 1:21-23. Why would a person exchange God's immortal glory for temporary images?

6. What is the difference between knowing or having a knowledge of God and honoring Him?
