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2. Why do you think it was easier for Abram to follow God's leading to move than it was to trust Him to take care of them in Egypt?

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3. Please look up the following verses and explain how they could have helped Abram with his decisions:

a. Proverbs 29:25

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b. Proverbs 28:26

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4. How did God protect Sarai in this situation?

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5. What do you learn about the power, wisdom, and mercy of God from this passage?

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## CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Obey fully, no matter how difficult the task or how old you are; Remember God's promises as you go; Never manage your fears with sinful plans. Always do what is right in God's eyes)?
