KEY PASSAGE: JOSHUA 1:1-9

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. From vs. 1-5, please list Joshua's responsibilities and God's responsibilities. How are Joshua's responsibilities different than God's?

2. Please read Numbers 32:11-12 and Deuteronomy 34:9. What do you see about Joshua that would qualify him to lead God's people?

3. How many times does God command Joshua to "be strong and courageous"?

a. Why do you think God repeated this command?

b. What reason does God give for why Joshua can be strong and courageous?

c. How does this impact you in your circumstances?

4. According to vs. 8, why is it important to know and meditate on God's word?

5. Please rephrase vs. 8 saying its opposite meaning. How would Joshua have led the people if he lived out the opposite of vs. 8, and what would have been the result? How do we sometimes live out the opposite of vs. 8?

6. What do you see about God's goodness, wisdom, and power from this passage?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. See where God is moving and step forward with Him; Be strong and courageous, facing any fears that well up)?
