KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 1:1-5

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. How has God chosen to speak to us throughout history, and what impact does His communication to us have on your understanding of Him?

2. Please describe each phrase, the opposite of their meaning, and the implication they have on our understanding of God:

a. Heir of all things

b. Creator of the world

c. Radiance of the glory of God

d. Exact imprint of God's nature

e. Upholds the universe together by the word of His power

f. How would you summarize this list into one statement about Jesus?

3. At that time, the idea of worshiping angels was prevalent. What does this passage help us understand about the authority of angels? What are some things we place as having higher authority than Jesus today?

4. What do you learn about the relationship of Jesus and the Father from this passage?

5. How does the perspective of Jesus shared in this passage impact me when I face fears or frustrations in this world?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Believe: Jesus is a message of hope – our Creator and Sustainer; Trust: Jesus is our sacrifice, superior to all creation)?
