IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 1:6-14

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. In vs. 6, Jesus is called God's "firstborn," and in vs. 10 it says that He "laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning." What insight does this give you about the meaning of the word, "firstborn"?

2. What do vs. 6, 7, and 14 tell you about the origin, power, and purpose of angels?

3. In light of what you see happening in the world today, please describe and explain the impact of God's throne in vs. 8-9.

4. Please describe the power of God explained in vs. 10-12. How do knowing His power and that He is "the same, and His years have no end," affect the way you view your current circumstances?

5. Who are the "enemies" of the Lord and what is their future?

6. This passage speaks of God's eternal nature in several places. How does having an eternal perspective affect the way we live? How does having a mindset that only looks at life on earth affect the way we live?

7. What attribute of God in this passage stirs your worship at this time in your life?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Worship: Even the angels are directed to worship Jesus as God; Confess: Allow Him to be your eternal King)?
