KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 2:1-9

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. What is the “therefore” there for?

2. Please share an example of something in life that is easy to “drift away” from when we’re not intentional about it.

3. Please use Matthew 22:1-6 to explain the different ways we can “neglect so great a salvation.”

4. In Hebrews 1, we saw that Jesus is superior to the angels. Now in chapter 2, we see that Jesus was made “for a little while lower than the angels.” Please use Hebrews 2:8-9 to explain the reason for this.

5. If someone asked you why they should believe in Jesus when they see all the brokenness of the world around them, how would you use this passage to answer them?

6. Please list everything you see about Jesus from this passage. What is one aspect of Him from the passage that can give you hope or direction for a circumstance in your life today?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Hold fast to the message of hope in Jesus; Celebrate “God with Us”, our hope of salvation, crowned with glory)?
