2. What do the following scriptures teach you about suffering, and how do they apply to Jesus?

a. Romans 5:3-5

b. James 1:2-4

c. 1 Peter 1:6-7

3. Vs. 10 starts out, "For it was fitting that He..." speaking of God the Father. What do vs. 10-13 say about God the Father?

4. What is the significance of being the brother or sister of Jesus?

5. Please use vs. 14-15 to explain the reasons Jesus had to die?

6. According to vs. 17-18, what is significant about Jesus becoming a man?

7. Please read vs. 18 and describe different ways a person could treat others after having suffered in comparison to how Jesus treats us after having suffered.
