

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 3:1-6

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please use Hebrews 2:10-18 along with Hebrews 3:1 to explain what it means to be a brother or sister of Jesus.

2. Please list the ways this passage shows Moses modeling himself after God's example.

3. According to vs. 6, what is the evidence of being God's "house"? Please explain what that looks like practically.

4. This passage teaches that Jesus is the builder and owner of the church. Summit Point has now existed for 15 years, how long have you been coming to Summit? How have you seen God at work building this church for His glory?

5. We are his “church” (called out ones), his “house” (place he lives and resides), his “children” (family who get to call him Daddy), and so much more. What stirs your worship when you look at all you have in Jesus?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what is one way you can apply the hope of Jesus as builder and example in your life?
