5. From Hebrews 4:3-5, what is the evidence that God's rest has been set from the foundation of the world? If we truly grasp this rest of His, how will it impact the way we face our wilderness?
6. What do you see from this passage about God's
a. Sovereignty?
b. Wisdom?
c. Goodness?
