KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 4:6-13

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage (Draw near to God through Jesus, our unmatched High Priest; See your sin honestly and humbly. Allow it to shape how you approach God and man)?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please look back over chapter 3 and 4. How many times is the phrase, “Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts” repeated? Why do you think God has that phrase repeated so many times?

2. The word “strive” from vs 11 is best translated “eager, diligent, passionate, hungering”. What are the characteristics of a life that is “eager and diligent” for the rest that will be found in heaven? What are the characteristics of a life that is not eager for the rest found in Heaven?

3. What insight do you gain about God’s word from the following passages?

a. Hebrews 4:12

b. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

c. Psalm 19:7-9

4. What place does God's word have in entering God's rest?

5. How do faith, humility, pride, and unbelief affect how we prioritize God's word in our lives?
