KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 5:5-10

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please look back at the references from old testament verses about Jesus in Hebrews 1. Now compare them with Hebrews 5:5. What do you see about the character of Jesus as you compare these passages?
Please read Genesis 14:18-20 – a. Please list everything you can see about the significance of Melchizedek.
b. How does Jesus prove Himself to be a "priest forever after the order of Melchizedek" and from what you learned in the message, what makes that significant?
3. God never calls us to anything that He does not first model to us. What did Jesus model to us about: a. Prayer?
b. Obedience?
c. Suffering?

4. Hebrews 5:7b says that Jesus offered prayers to "Him who was able to save Him from death (see Matthew 26:39-42). The Father didn't save Jesus from death. Please explain how God was both sovereign and good in this situation, and how that applies into a situation in your own life.
5. According to verse 9 - a. What was the result of Jesus' obedience through suffering?
b. What would the result have been if He chose not to suffer?
c. How does that impact your view of suffering?
