

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 6:13-20

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage (Be true to your word like God, recognizing you answer to someone greater; be encouraged that God will never change His purpose or His word. He is rock solid and trustworthy)?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please read Genesis 12:1-3 and 22:15-18 and explain both God's promise and His oath to Abraham. What were the circumstances surrounding each?

2. According to vs. 17-18, what was God's purpose in guaranteeing His promise with an oath?

3. Why do you think the recipients of this letter needed "strong encouragement"?

4. In what circumstances that we face today do we need strong encouragement?

5. Please describe the words that give hope in this passage. Which words are most meaningful to you in your present circumstances?

6. Before Jesus, priests entered the presence of God as “representatives” of the people, but Jesus enters as a “forerunner.” Please explain the significance of this difference between Jesus and the priests, and how that impacts our lives.

7. What inspires your worship from this passage about God’s authority, power, and goodness?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what is one area of your life that you need to run to God as your refuge and anchor your hope in Him, and what is one step that you’ll take toward doing that?
