

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 8:8-13

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage (See the purpose of the law, and its shortcoming; Embrace the glory of the new covenant in Jesus)?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Please compare Hebrews 8:8-9 with Exodus 19:5. What is man's responsibility in each covenant? What does this tell you about the superiority of the new covenant?

2. How is God's plan in the new covenant to put His "laws into their minds, and write them on their minds" different from the old covenant? What makes that superior?

3. So if the law is no longer written on stone in the New Covenant but rather is written on our hearts, how would you answer someone that says, "I no longer have to follow the 10 Commandments since they are Old Covenant and obsolete?"

4. Please compare vs. 9 with Nehemiah 9:16-21. What do you see about God's goodness and mercy in these verses?

5. How do we falsely make golden calves today?

6. What is the reason that God wants us NOT to need a teacher? What do you see in this passage that points to the kind of relationship God wants to have with us?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what is one practical thing you can do to know God (not just about God) better?
