

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 9:1-5

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage (Thank God that we no longer interact with Him through an earthly tabernacle; Thank God that we no longer have to see Him through shadows of what's to come)?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Why do you think God intricately designed shadows that would point to Jesus (like the tabernacle and all of its details)?

2. In vs 1-2, we see the Holy Place. This was the area that the priests would go into daily to pray and care for the tabernacle. There are 3 items in the Holy Place. What might those represent about Jesus?

a. The Bread

b. The Light of the Mennorah

c. The Incense before the Holy of Holies

3. Psalm 105:5 says, “Remember the wondrous works that He has done, His miracles, and the judgements He uttered.” God had the manna, Aaron’s budded rod, and the 10 Commandments placed in the Ark in order to remember His works. What might you choose as an object that represents God’s work in your life? Why?

4. The Ark of the Covenant was in the Holy of Holies where only the High Priest could go, and then only one time per year. What does that reveal about the holiness of God?

5. The tabernacle overall represents the privilege we have of connecting with the God of the Universe. The details reveal many facets to our privilege with God. What is one privilege that stood out to you this week?
